Deakin truly is an international university

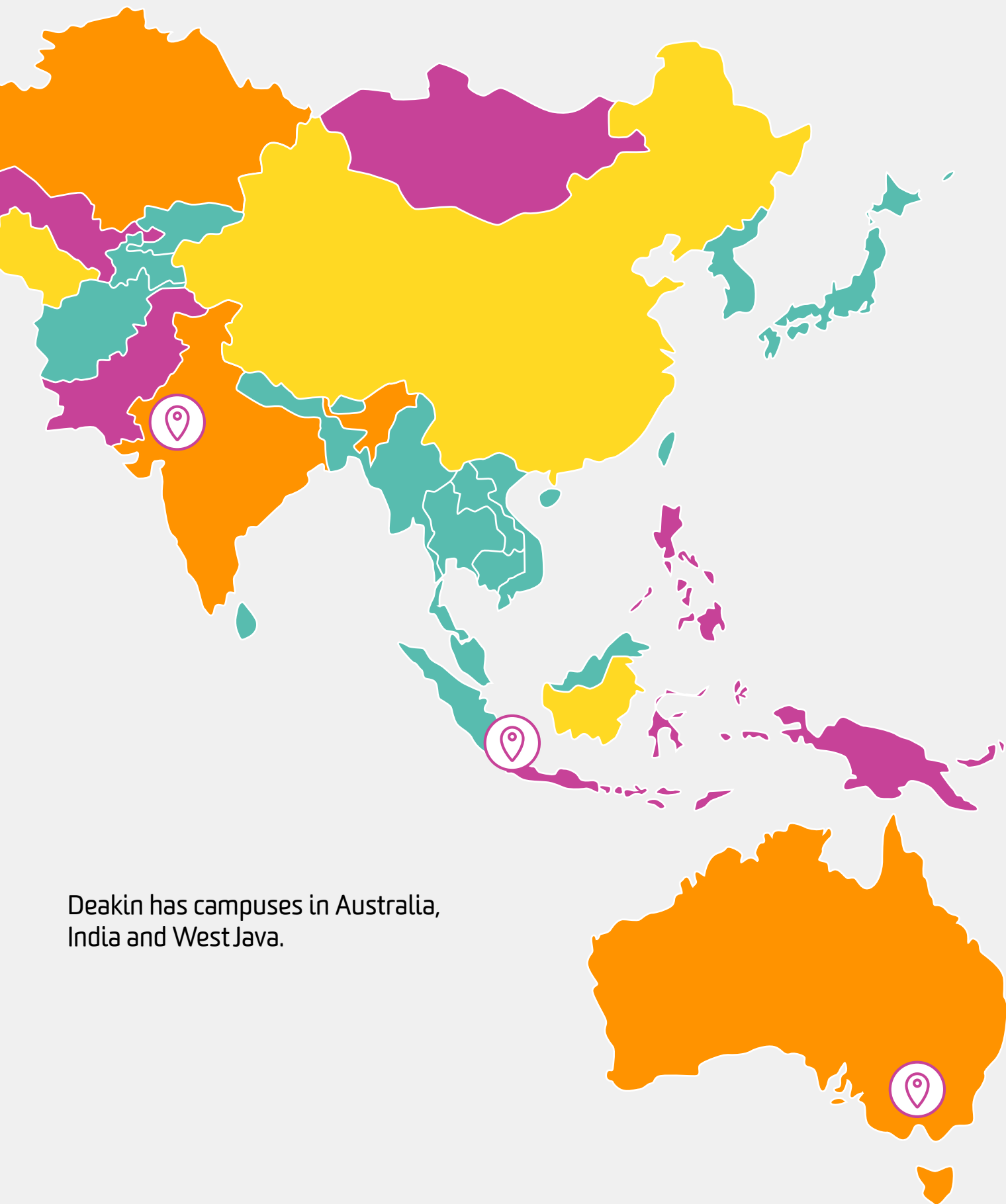

Pathways to registration as a psychologist



To obtain registration as a provisional psychologist, you will need to complete four years of psychology studies recognised by the Psychology Board of Australia. After completing a Deakin undergraduate psychology degree or external bachelor degree (with an Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC) accredited three-year major sequence in psychology)¹, there are a number of further study options you can take to be eligible for general registration.

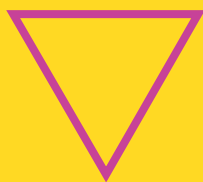

Entry requirements



Each Deakin postgraduate degree has its own eligibility and academic entry requirements.

► Masters by coursework

Deakin masters by coursework programs are typically 18 months to two years full time, or up to four years part time. Many degrees allow you to choose a 'specialisation' – the area of study from which you choose the majority of your units. Studies are completed mainly through coursework, with a thesis or major project completed in the last part of the degree.

Admission requirements

Applicants are required to have completed at least a bachelor degree, or comparable, of an acceptable standard from an approved university or other educational institution. Some degrees may have additional entry requirements, which you can find on the Deakin website.

Masters degrees by coursework that include a research stream may provide a possible pathway to PhD candidature.

► Graduate certificates and graduate diplomas

Graduate certificates are usually one trimester in duration and are designed to add practical and vocational skills to your undergraduate degree, diploma or previous work experience. Graduate diplomas are usually two trimesters in duration. They are designed to build on the understanding and skills developed during a graduate certificate, or from work experience.

Admission requirements

Applicants seeking entry into a graduate certificate or graduate diploma program must have successfully completed:

- an approved undergraduate degree, or comparable, from an approved university or other educational institution; or
- comparable qualifications gained by examination or relevant professional or industry experience.

Additional requirements may exist for certain degrees.

Visas

International students who want to study in Australia require a visa. This could be a student visa.¹ It is important that you know the type of visa you are granted so that you can meet the requirements of that visa.

English language requirements

To enrol in a Deakin degree, you will need to be able to read, speak, write and listen in English at a certain level. Students must provide evidence of at least one of the following:

- Obtaining the required scores on a recognised English language test, such as IELTS or TOEFL.
- Completed university (tertiary) or high school (secondary) studies taught in English.
- Lived and worked in an English-speaking country for at least five years.

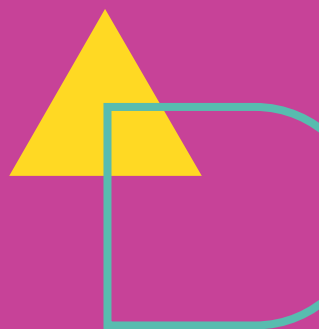

STEP 4

GATHER SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

When you submit your application to Deakin, make sure you attach all required supporting documentation. Otherwise, your application could be delayed or, even worse, rejected. Give yourself plenty of time to get organised. All documents must be translated into English. Most documents, such as transcripts and identification, need to be certified before they are submitted to Deakin.

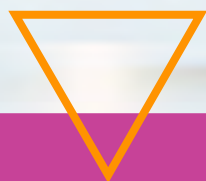
